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HOME ONSHORE WIND THUMBS UP FOR SCOTIAN WINDFIELDS

Thumbs up for Scotian Windfields

Nova Scotia regulators have approved the 6MW Martock Ridge community feed-in tariff (COMFIT) project after developer Scotian Windfields amended the environmental assessment.

The Halifax-based outfit provided additional information regarding proximity to receptors and demonstrating compliance with setback distances, noise levels and shadow flicker guidelines after the environment minister ruled in March that the environmental assessment report was insufficient, as reported in reNews.

Scotian has a master framework agreement with Vestas for a plus-50MW portfolio of projects. The Danish manufacturer is on tap to supply V100 2MW (pictured) machines although some sites may use different models. Vestas will also handle foundation construction and turbine erection.

The projects are owned in partnership with community investment outfit Scotian Wind and WEB Wind Energy North America, a subsidiary of Austria-based WEB Windenergie AG.

The proponents also hold COMFIT contracts for 8MW North Beaverbank, 5MW Nine Mile River, and several single-turbine 1.99MW projects: Parker Mountain, Little River, Isle Madame, Glen Tosh and Saint Rose.
